2nd District level Online Quiz Competition for Red Ribbon Club (RRC) Colleges: 2021

Nagaland State AIDS Control Society will be conducting the 2nd district level online quiz competition 2021 **#RRCAgainstHIV** for the Red Ribbon Club members, with the aim to actively involve and engage members of RRC in disseminating information about HIV/AIDS and other health related issues, and make them discuss about it through the mode of quiz.

The guiz competition will have four phases:

- 1. District level quiz competition
- 2. State Level quiz competition
- 3. Regional level quiz competition
- 4. National level quiz competition

The district and State level competition will be organized by NSACS. However the Regional and National level competition will be organized by NACO.

- 1. The online quiz competition is open to all the existing Red Ribbon Clubs in the colleges/institutes in the 12 districts of Nagaland.
- 2. The online quiz competition will be conducted through NSACS YOUTH APP launched by the Hon'ble Minister (H&FW) Shri S. Pangyu Phom on the 5th of November, 2020.
- 3. In order to participate in the quiz competition, a student will have to download the **NSACS Youth App** from the Google play store and register in the portal through mobile phone. The participant is to register with his/her personal email account, official name as per college ID card, name of the college and the district where it is located (no matter from whichever district he/she may be registering).
- 4. Non RRC members will be disqualified during the result screening. The authentication will be done by respective colleges/institutes.
- 5. The competition will start at $\underline{12 \text{ noon on the } 16^{\text{th}} \text{ of July, } 2021}$ (uniform for all the districts).
 - 6. Publicity and promotion of the competition will be done using the official social media platforms like Facebook, twitter, Instagram, website and through whatsapp.
 - 7. The MCQ will have 50 questions related to HIV/AIDS, Adolescent Health, Sexually Transmitted Infections, Safe sexual behavior, TB, Drug Abuse and major public health concerns.
 - 8. The time allotted will be of 30 minutes.
 - 9. Every question carries 01 mark; there will be no negative marking.

- 10. Quiz will be made available to each district at the same time through the NSACS YOUTH APP.
- 11. The winners (First and Second) of the district level will further compete in the state level competition which will be conducted at a later date.

12. <u>District level Prize with certificates (each district):</u>

- **1.** FIRST PRIZE: Cash prize of Rs. 10,000/- and a certificate
- **2.** SECOND PRIZE: Cash prize of Rs. 7,000/- and a certificate
- **3.** THIRD PRIZE: Cash prize of Rs. 5,000/- and a certificate
- **4.** 3 Consolation prizes: Cash prize of Rs. 2000/- each along with certificates.
